To all parents with children starting in 1st grade autumn of 2022

12 free weekly hours for 1st graders attending SFO

(Before and after school-programme)

When your child starts school in the autumn, you will also be offered SFO. A new, national scheme has been decided for the coming 1st grade, where 12 hours of free stay at SFO are offered every week. In addition to this, one can buy full-time stay. The scheme applies to all school starters in 2022/2023.

Ås municipality offers these free hours in the afternoon, from the time the school ends to a certain time every afternoon. Pupils in 1st grade can be approx. 2,5 hours at SFO after school Monday - Thursday, and approx. 2 hours after school on Friday, for free. In addition, the free scheme includes 3 days stay during holidays when the school is closed and SFO is open.

The schools in Ås have different timetables, therefore the pupils in 1st grade end their school day at various times. At Brønnerud, Kroer, Sjøskogen and Solberg, pupils can stay free at SFO until 15:45 Monday to Thursday and until 15:15 on Fridays. At Nordby, Rustad and Åsgård, students in 1st grade can stay free at SFO until 16.00 Monday to Thursday and until kl. 15.30 on Fridays.

Both when hours are set and the deduction for free hours in full-time subsistence allowance. The changes may come during the school year 2022/2023 or at the start of the school year 2023/2024.

Full time stay for pupils in 1st grade

Parents who want their child to be at SFO in the morning before school starts, longer afternoons or several days during the holidays, can apply for a full-time stay in SFO. A full-time stay for pupils in 1st grade will cost NOK 1 725 pr. month. The 12 hours of free stay are deducted from the payment for full-time stay, which is NOK. 3 317. With full-time stay the child can stay all days and all holidays where the school is closed and SFO is open.

Apply for stay in SFO

You apply for SFO stay via [Oppvekstportalen](#), which you can find on the [municipality's websites](#). The application deadline has been postponed to April 20th. Everyone who has been given a school place receives SFO place at the same school. The new search options for 1st graders will be available in Oppvekstportalen from April 1st, 2022. If you already have applied for full-time stay for your school starter and still want this, you do not need to do anything. Your parental payment will be NOK 1 725 pr. month. If you have applied for a full-time place, but would rather have a free place, contact your SFO at the school your child will start. You will find contact information at the [municipality website](#). The SFO leader at your school can also help you with other questions you may have.
